General requirements:

- The research work must be consistent with the conference’s aim, objective, and topic;
- The research work must be based on a certain theory and methodology;
- Presentation paper size shall be A4, text size 2 cm from each side of the page, line spacing "1.15", font type "Arial", font height "12", MS Word, no grammatical or technical errors, 5-8 pages;
- Citations, footnotes, and explanations of used sources must be included without violating copyright or intellectual property rights;
- The presentation should include author’s name, a brief introduction of the speaker, keywords, abstract, main body, conclusions, suggestions, and a references;
- Paper and presentation should be written in English;
- Can participate in the conference individually or in a team of 2 people.

Submission deadline:

Papers will be accepted by e-mail: lmaa.m@yahoo.com until 11:59 p.m. on October 27, 2024.

Submitted papers will be screened according to requirements /Plagiarism checker/.

Discussion:

The speaker will present their report in English in 8-10 minutes and discuss it in no more than 7-10 minutes.

Organizing:

The conference will be conducted online using the Zoom platform in English, within the scope of the discussion topics.

Conference result:

Papers discussed at the conference and those that meet the requirements will be made available to the public through an electronic proceeding.

An electronic certificate will be issued to the speakers who attended the conference.
